Ilfracombe Harbour, North Devon

Built around its harbour, with whitewashed houses and elegant villas, Ilfracombe developed rapidly during the Victorian era, when a pier was constructed for ferries from Bristol. In the tiny chapel of St Nicholas on the Lantern Hill promontory, a light has shone to guide sailors into the harbour since 1320.

Little Langdale Tarn, Cumbria

Palace House, Beaulieu, Hampshire

Built in the 13th century as the gatehouse for Beaulieu Abbey, home to the Montagu family since 1538, the house was extended in the 16th and 19th centuries and is a fine example of a Gothic country house. It overlooks Beaulieu River in the New Forest amidst lawns and walkways and the National Motor Museum.

Aberglaslyn Pass, Snowdonia

The River Glaslyn winds through the dramatic and scenic rocky pass of Aberglaslyn. It narrows until the road and the river are hemmed in by steep wooded hillsides. A path runs along the east side of the ravine, with fine views of the river as it roars over huge boulders creating rapids and deep pools.

Harthorpe Valley, Northumberland

Chalk Cliffs near Eastbourne, East Sussex

The setting sun highlights the shoreline and tide pools below the dazzling white chalk cliffs where the South Downs meet the sea. The base of the cliffs, exposed to the incoming tide, is constantly eroded, forming caves, gulleys and channels in the chalk and depositing large chalk piles on the foreshore.

Radcliffe Camera, Oxford

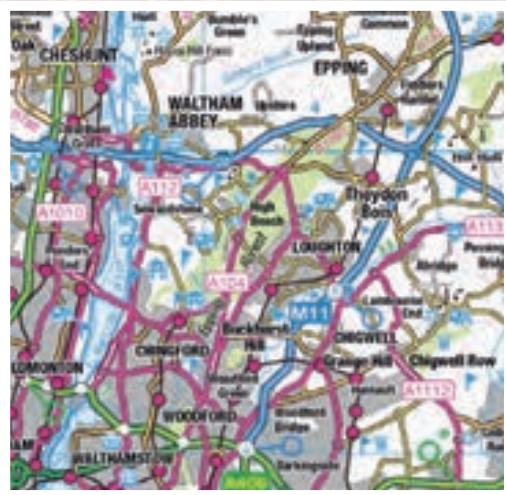
