Jurassic Coast, Dorset

The white chalk cliffs at Swyre Head tower above the shingle beach, with a huge dry valley along the top. Stretching 95 miles (153 km), the Jurassic Coast has been sculpted by the sea into outstanding landforms such as chalk stacks and rock arches, and contains many fossilised remains of ancient sea creatures.

British Museum, London

Founded in 1753, the British Museum is devoted to human history and culture with a collection of 8 million works. The Great Court, opened in 2000, is the central quadrangle covered by a tessellated glass roof. It surrounds the circular, domed Reading Room and former library, built in 1857, and now a museum.

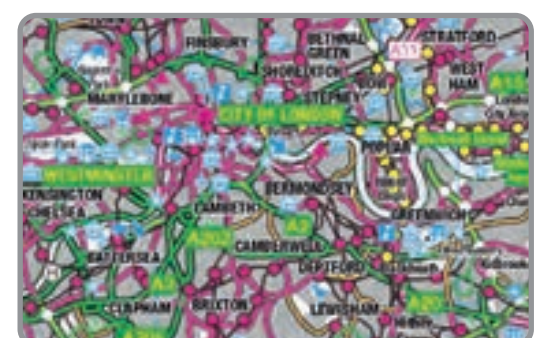

Fairy Pools, Glenbrittle, Isle of Skye

Many tributaries of the River Brittle descend from the jagged Cuillin mountains into Glenbrittle, a wide, rocky glen. One of these streams flows into the Fairy Pools, enchanting rock pools of translucent mountain spring water, fed by a series of dramatic waterfalls. They are popular for wild swimming.

Perch Rock Lighthouse, New Brighton, Merseyside

On the north tip of the Wirral Peninsula, the lighthouse was built in 1827 near the coastal defence battery of Perch Rock at the mouth of Liverpool Bay. Constructed of marble rock, it was in use until 1973. Surrounded by the sea at high tide, it is part of a large coastal park of sand dunes and grassland.

North Downs Woodland, Kent

In Spring, bluebells make a blaze of blue colour in woodland on the North Downs ridge of chalk hills. Stretching from Farnham, Surrey to the White Cliffs of Dover, the North Downs Way National Trail runs along the ridge. The steep slopes are covered by chalk grassland, supporting rich flora and fauna.

Craster Harbour, Northumberland

This fishing port is famous for its kippers (smoked herrings), produced for centuries in the local smokehouse. Protected by sturdy walls, the harbour was built in 1906. The dramatic ruins of Dunstanburgh Castle, the largest in Northumberland, built from 1313 to 1332, stand on a remote clifftop near Craster.

Clapper Bridge, Postbridge, North Devon

This fine bridge, across the East Dart river in the heart of Dartmoor National Park, is believed to date back to medieval times, to help packhorses transporting tin to Tavistock cross the river. The bridge has two central piers spanned by three large granite slabs, or clappers, each 4m long and 2m wide.

Castlerigg Stone Circle, nr. Keswick, Cumbria

Sited within a natural amphitheatre of fells above Keswick, Castlerigg Stone Circle consists of 38 unhewn boulders, some standing, some fallen. Dating from 3000 BC, it is one of Britain's earliest stone circles. It may have been used in prehistoric times as an astronomical observatory or a trading place.
