Staithes, North Yorkshire

Fishermen's cottages cluster next to Staithes harbour, sheltered by towering sandstone cliffs, with the river flowing down from the moors to meet the sea. A maze of cobbled streets and alleyways, it was once one of the largest fishing ports on the northeast coast, using traditional low-sided coble boats.

Thames Barrier, Woolwich, London

Opened in 1984, the Thames Barrier is a retractable barrier system built to protect Greater London from exceptionally high tides and storm surges moving up from the North Sea. Spanning 52m across the Thames, its 10 large gates can be raised or lowered to protect millions of residents and vital infrastructure.

Bamburgh Castle, Northumberland

Dramatically set on a basalt 45m outcrop, overlooking two glorious sandy beaches and dunes, this imposing 11th-century Norman fortress was built on the site of a Roman stronghold. It comprises a massive curtain wall, a keep and elongated battlements, a dungeon and a richly decorated and furnished interior.

It was not a commercial success, so was abandoned in 1944, but it was retained as a water supply channel. The Standedge Tunnel near Diggle is the longest, highest, and deepest canal tunnel in the UK.
