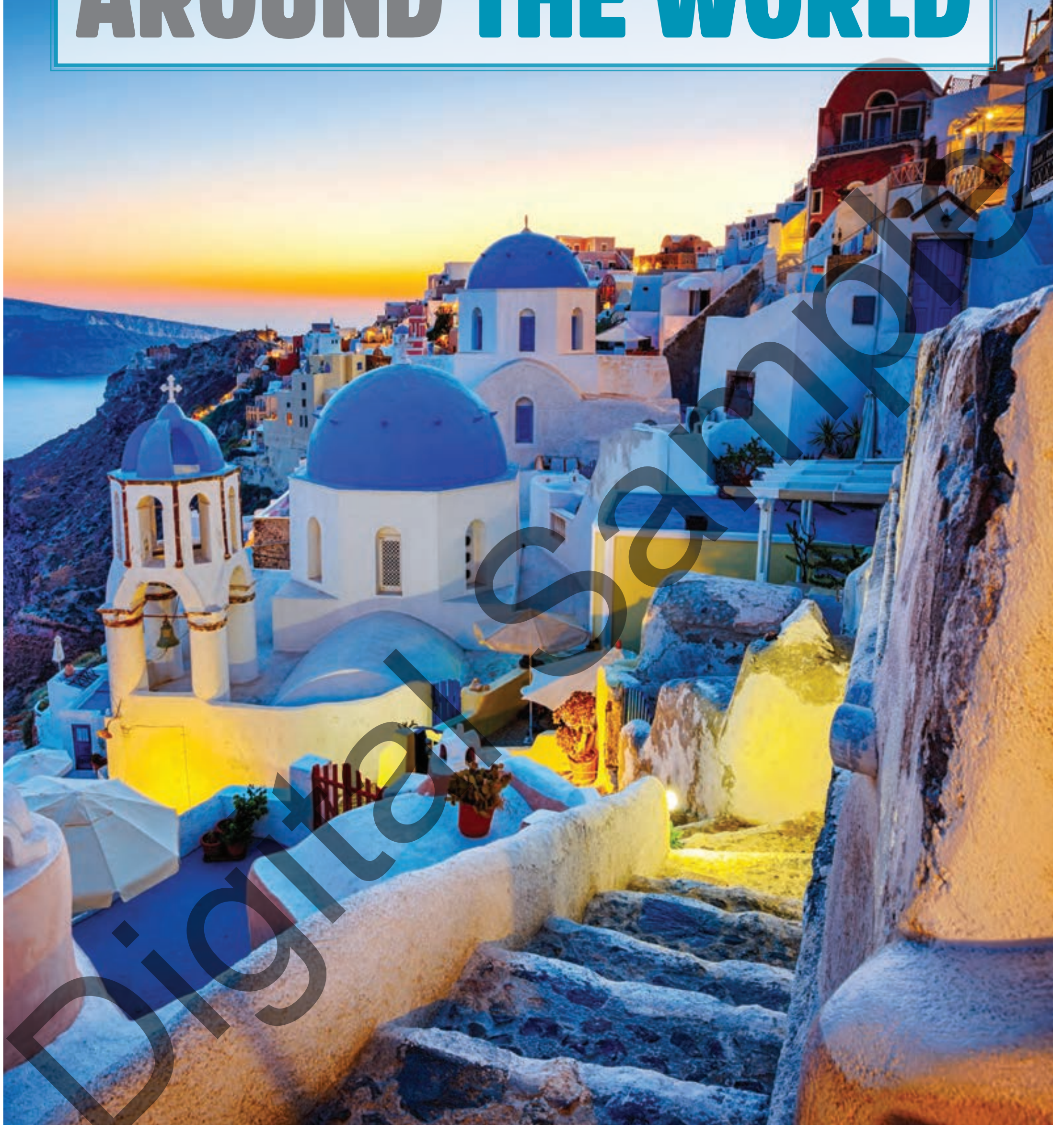

Instantly recognisable, depicted in countless works of Japanese art, Mount Fuji towers at a height of 3,776m above the Tokyo skyline. This exotic chain of about 370 tropical islands off the Caribbean coast of Panama is surrounded by some of the world's oldest reefs. Forty-nine of the islands are inhabited and are run independently. They are famous for their traditional decorative art, the Molas – bright fabrics with colourful geometric patterns. Southern stingrays inhabit warm, shallow waters and seek prey buried in sand. They have a large, flat, diamond-shaped body and a venomous sting.

The beautiful hilltop town of Ainsa is set in a mountainous landscape in the southern Pyrenees. Capital of the old kingdom of Sobrarbe, which became part of the kingdom of Aragón in the 11th century, it is a fine example of medieval city design with an old quarter of closely packed houses, a Collegiate Church and an enormous castle enclosure. The goshawk is a fierce-looking raptor with powerful wings to weave through forests as it hunts its prey.

Oia, Santorini, Greece
and Little Owl

The picturesque village of Oia has many blue-domed churches and whitewashed cuboid houses and is renowned for its spectacular sunset views. It is dramatically situated on steep 300m cliffs, which are the outer edge of a collapsed caldera of a volcano forming the island of Santorini. The little owl nests in cavities in trees and rocks here and is usually seen at dusk in low, undulating flight, or standing upright and alert with staring yellow eyes.

Hegra, AlUla, Saudi Arabia
and Sinai Agama

AROUND THE WORLD

Dating from the Nabataean Kingdom in the 1st century AD, Hegra contains over 110 burial tombs, expertly carved from desert rock into huge stone blocks, or betyls, which represented the gods. Well-preserved stone inscriptions illustrate the development of the Arabic language. The Sinai agama is a small lizard that hunts for insects, mostly ants, in the arid terrain. In the breeding season, the male's body, or parts of its head and throat turn blue.

Moraine Lake, Banff National Park, Canada and Grizzly Bear

This crystal-clear lake lies below a moraine (rock pile left by glaciers), its vivid turquoise colour in summer due to light refraction by particles of glacial silt washed down from the mountains. Banff National Park has some of Canada's most outstanding scenery: alpine peaks, azure lakes, giant ice fields, glaciers, rivers and waterfalls. Grizzly bears can be spotted here, especially near rivers and streams, which provide a plentiful supply of fish.
