LEADERFOOT VIADUCT
SCOTTISH BORDERS

CALEDONIA

This striking viaduct was built in 1865 to carry the Berwickshire Railway across the River Tweed just east of Melrose. Nineteen high, slender arches made of brick for extra stability support the railway bed. The rest of the structure is built of large blocks of dressed pinkish-red sandstone, giving it a reddish hue.

BOW FIDDLE ROCK MORAY						
CALEDONIA						

Carved by waves into a natural arch resembling a violin bow, this striking offshore quartzite rock feature is one of many prominent arches, sea stacks and caves along the Moray Firth. It appears white because of the layers of bird droppings, as it is a nesting site for species of gulls, fulmars and cormorants.
